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Background:

Suicide is a significant public health problem in the United States and New York State (NYS). Over the last decade, the suicide death rate increased by 27% in NYS, surpassing deaths by motor vehicle accidents, homicides, and most recently breast cancer. Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death among all age groups - with devastating consequences for individuals, families, communities and society at large.

The Challenge: Statistically rare and yet shockingly common, suicide is a complex problem that calls for coordinated community prevention and healthcare system approaches. New York State's Suicide Prevention Plan provides a framework for meeting this challenge. A copy of the plan can be found [here](#).

Topics

To promote collaboration across disciplines in the areas of research, surveillance, clinical and community interventions, OMH Suicide Prevention Office and the Suicide Prevention Center of New York are issuing a call for presentations and posters for the 2nd Statewide Suicide Prevention Conference. Submissions should align with the three strategies within the NYS Suicide Prevention Plan:

- 1) Prevention in Health and Behavior Healthcare Settings,
- 2) Prevention across the Lifespan in Communities, and
- 3) Surveillance and Data to inform Suicide Prevention.

After review, those chosen will be invited to present either at a 75-minute concurrent session, alone or as a member of a panel discussion, or at the evening poster session. Deadline for submission is May 7th, 2017. Accepted proposals will be notified no later than May 31st, 2017.

Eligibility:

Presenters from academic, research, health / mental health/substance abuse and community settings are encouraged to apply.

Project must be taking place in NYS.

Content must be consistent with safe messaging guidelines.

Presenters must register for the Conference.

Those presenting posters must be present during poster session.

Poster sessions cannot be used to advertise products or to display vendor items.
